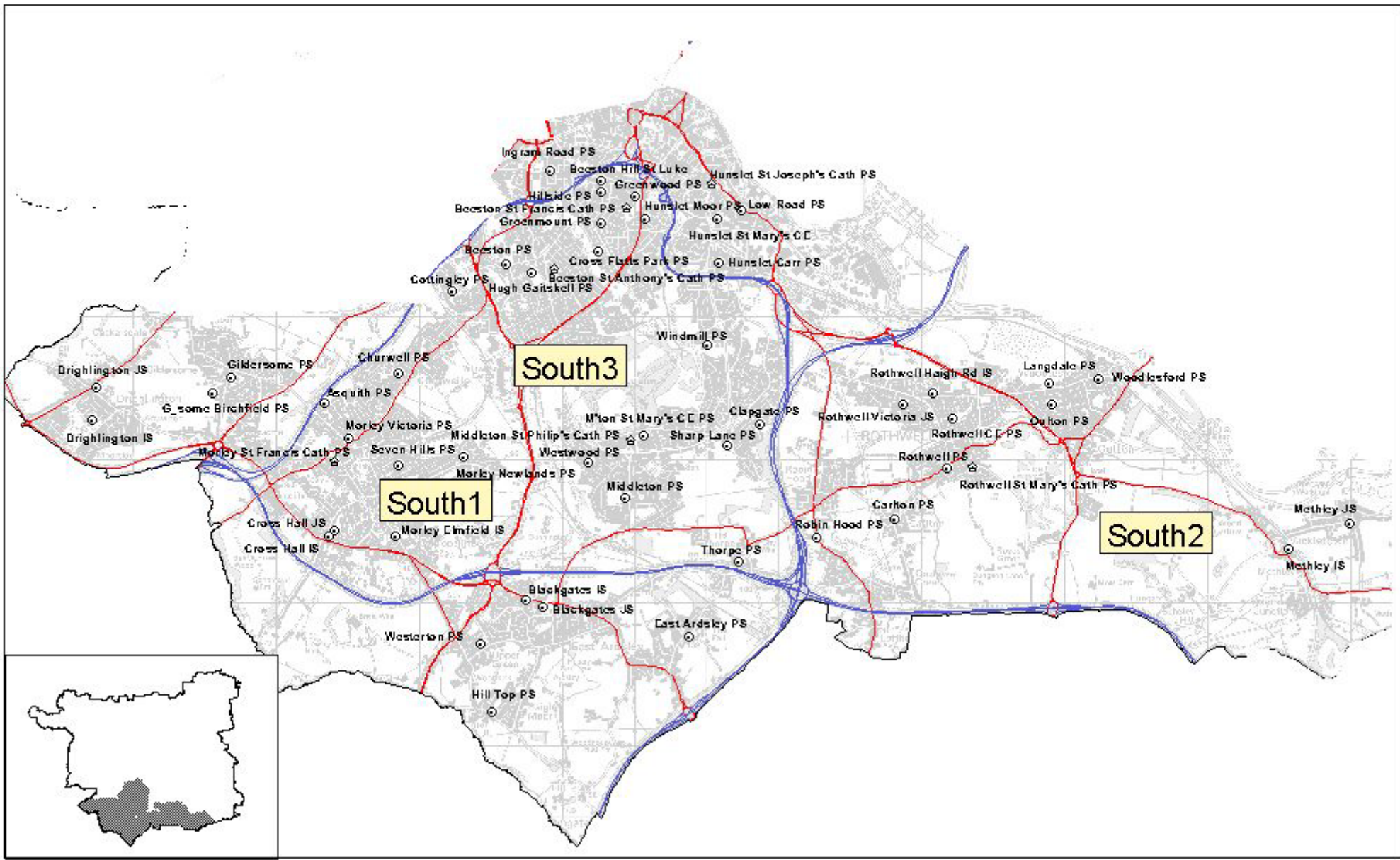

Current Proposals

Morley South Planning Area: The Executive Board of Leeds City Council has approved proposals to close Blackgates Infant and Blackgates Junior schools and establish a new two form of entry primary school and to increase Westerton Primary School's admission number to 90 across all year groups from September 2004. East Ardsley Primary has been identified for a consolidation scheme onto one site in the 10 school PFI scheme with a revised admission limit of 45. **Gildersome/Drighlington Planning Area:** The Executive Board of Leeds City Council has approved proposals to close Drighlington Infant and Drighlington Junior Schools and establish a new two form of entry primary school from September 2004. **Morley Central Planning Area:** Morley Newlands Primary will revert to its admission number of 45 from September 2003.

New Housing Developments

There is outline planning permission for a development of 100 dwellings at Harrop Avenue, Morley. A site has been identified at Bruntcliffe Road, Morley for 180 dwellings although this is unlikely to proceed for at least 10 years. There are a number of small developments totalling around 90 dwellings throughout Drighlington at various stages of completion. There are two large developments planned at Manor House Farm, Churwell totalling 330 dwellings, some of which are already under construction. There is a further planned development for 100 dwellings at Daisy Hill, Morley which is unlikely to proceed for at least 10 years. There are three small developments planned in West Ardsley, two at Woolin Crescent and one at Batley Road, which amount to 90 dwellings some of which are already under construction. Ardsley Sidings, East Ardsley has outline planning permission for around 600 dwellings. An application to develop 300 units as Phase I has been received.

Current Proposals

Methley Planning Area: The Executive Board of Leeds City Council has approved proposals to close Methley Infant and Methley Junior schools and establish a new two form of entry primary school in September 2004 which will be part of the 10 school PFI scheme.

Rothwell Planning Area: Rothwell Primary has been identified for a consolidation scheme onto one site in the 10 school PFI scheme with a revised admission limit of 45.

Woodlesford Planning Area: Following public consultation, a notice has been published of proposals to close Langdale Primary School and to expand Woodlesford Primary School. If this proposal proceeds, a final decision by School Organisation Committee is expected by January 2004.

New Housing Developments

There are developments on Leeds Road, Robin Hood, totalling 175 dwellings which are at varying stages of construction. There is a further planned development at Milner Lane, Robin Hood which is unlikely to proceed for at least 10 years. There is a planned development for 230 dwellings at St George's Hospital, Rothwell for which planning permission has not yet been granted.

Current Proposals

Holbeck Planning Area: Leeds City Council has undertaken public consultation to close Greenwood and Hillside Primary schools, and to open a new I.5 form entry primary school on the Greenwood site. This proposal's progress is dependant upon a targeted capital bid.

New Housing Developments

There is a planned development for 100 dwellings at Stourton North which is unlikely to proceed for at least 10 years. There are two developments at Sweet Street one of which is for 241 apartments and is under construction, and one for 168 apartments not yet started. There is a further development at Butcher Street LSI for 88 dwellings already under construction. Holbeck 'Urban Village' is a substantial planned development for around 900 mixed dwellings but it is anticipated that the majority of these will be apartments. Clarence Dock has planning permission for 525 apartments in total and these are in various stages of construction. None of these developments are likely to produce significant numbers of primary age children. There are two further developments, one at Bowman Lane which is under construction, and one at Victoria Road, LS2 which has not yet started. Again these developments are mainly apartments. A development of around 1200 houses at Sharp Lane is likely to proceed in the next five years and developers are being made aware of the need to contribute to enhancing primary provision.
